SATURDAY BREAKFAST

Come to Downtown Lewistown and grab drink at East End—this is our place! Try one of our seasonal lattes, a single origin house brew or a cold jar. Take a walk downtown on Market Street and pop in a few shops like **the Dragonfly** (antique consignment), **Snowflake's Christmas Shoppe**, **Penny Station** (model trains), and **Bon Ton** department store. In warm weather, consider the **Farmers Market**, or a longer stroll to **Victory Park**. The **Mifflin County Historical Society** has a self-guided walking tour of downtown architecture that you can download from their website.
