So, What is Goose Day?

This local tradition has been observed in the Juniata River Valley for over two centuries, carried here by an early local settler. Legend has it that if you eat goose on Michaelmas Day, you will never want for money all the year round. Believers of this tradition adhere faithfully to this tradition and eat goose every September 29th, St. Michaelmas Day, thus ensuring wealth and prosperity for the coming year. In the 1970's, both the Mifflin & Juniata County Commissioners issued formal proclamations establishing Goose Day as official county holidays.

Goose Day is the American version of Michaelmas, a Christian festival observed on September 29. It honors Archangel Michael for defeating Satan in the war in heaven. It is said that when St. Michael threw the devil from heaven, he fell from the skies and landed in a prickly blackberry bush. Satan cursed the fruit, scorched them with his fiery breath, stamped and spat on them, so that they would be unfit for eating. Folklore suggests that Michaelmas Day is the last day to eat blackberries.






