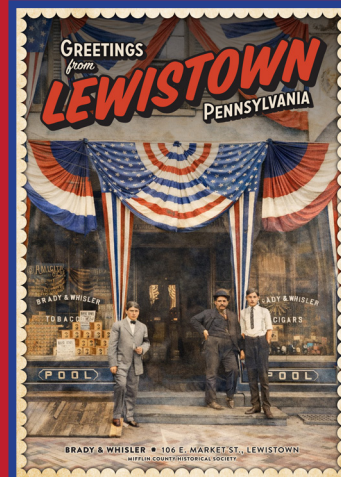

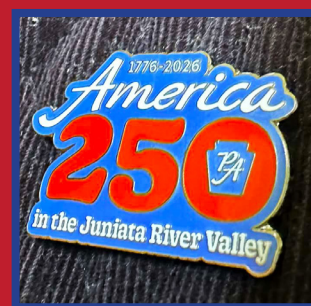

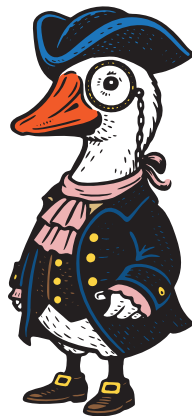
Lucky Friday- September 25th

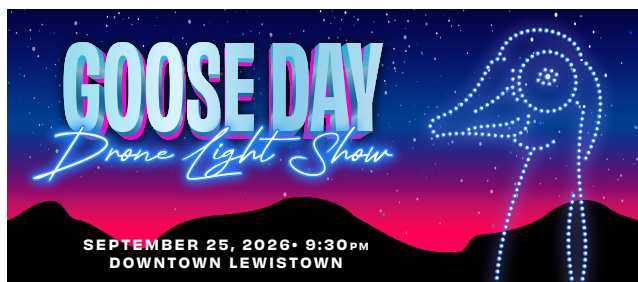

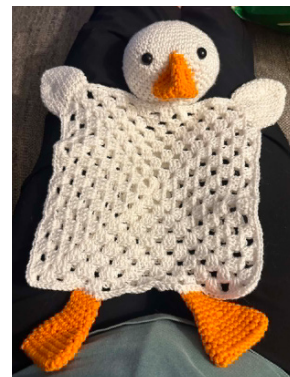
